

1. Nationality/education requirements

A. First-year applicants

- ▶ (Nationality) If both the applicant and their parents are foreign nationals
- ▶ (Education) Foreigners who have completed all educational courses equivalent to Korean elementary and secondary education in Korea or abroad
- ▶ Applicants with dual nationality are not accepted as foreigners

B. Transfer students (3rd year): Applicants with first-year enrollment qualifications who fall under one of the following three criteria:

- ▶ Applicants who are enrolled in or have completed at least their 2nd year (2 years or 4 semesters based on a 1 year/2 semester system, excluding summer/winter semesters) and earned at least 1/2 of credits required for graduation at a 4-year university
- ▶ Graduates of junior colleges (including expected graduates)
- ▶ Undergraduate degree holder

C. Transfer students (4th year): Applicants with first-year enrollment qualifications who fall under the following two criteria:

- ▶ Applicants who have completed their 3rd year in a college majoring in a 3-year course and graduated or scheduled to graduate
- ▶ Applicants who have graduated or will graduate in the same or compatible major will be accepted
(※ It is necessary to check with the International Education Center before applying.)

2. Minimum language proficiency requirement: Applicants must fall under one of the following criteria

C. Foreign applicants residing in Korea will have an in-person interview, whereas foreign applicants residing outside of Korea will have a phone or video interview



Application Fee



1. Application Fee Payment

A. Application Fee: KRW 80,000

2. How to Pay

A. In person: Cash payment

B. Mail: Submit a remittance check (recipient: **상지대학교** or Sangji University) along with the application documents

C. Bank account transfer: Transfer the application fee with the applicant’s name into the designated payment account (Shinhan Bank 100-017-491671 Sangji University). Notify the applicant’s name, nationality, payment date, payment amount, and payment bank via e-mail (iphak@sangji.ac.kr) to the Admissions Office.

3. Application Fee Refund

A. In order to ensure fairness in college admissions and to minimize damage to other candidates, the application cannot be withdrawn once submitted.

B. Application fee refunds: Application Fee Refund: Application fee will be refunded in full or partial in the following cases

- All required documents, including the application form, must be filled out. The education field on the application form must be accurately filled out starting with high school education and respective dates of attendance.
- Multiple applications are not accepted.
- Originals must be submitted for all documents (except for those documents specified as "copies" or "photocopies"). If copies are submitted instead of originals, you must submit the originals within the registration period following your admission.
- Documents not written in Korean or English must be translated into Korean or English and notarized.
- Students with insufficient or non-submitted documents will be disqualified.
- Admission/enrollment will be canceled even after acceptance in the event of forged/altered documents or admissions fraud during the admissions process in the future.
- Admission/enrollment will be canceled for admitted/enrolled individuals if he/she is unable to enter the country or is denied a visa.
- The admission of prospective graduates at the time of application will be canceled if they fail to graduate before the start of the first semester of 2024 for spring applicants and the start of the second semester of 2024 for fall applicants.
- Information written in the application form may not be altered after submission.
- Application may not be withdrawn after submission, and submitted documents and application fee are not returned. However, the disqualified applicant will be refunded the interview fee of KRW 20,000 to the bank account for tuition refund.
- Interviewees must bring their ID (either passport or Residence Card) with them on the day of the interview.
- Admitted applicants must check the university's website on the day of announcement of admitted applicants, as they will not be contacted individually.
- Admitted applicants must pay their tuition into the bank account designated by Sangji University within the registration period, and those applicants who fail to pay the tuition during the said period will be disqualified.
- Documents other than the original copy of diploma and TOPIK certificate will not be returned, and assessment results will not be disclosed.
- After enrollment, the required documents for overseas academic background check must be submitted when requested by the University. Students who fail to submit such documents, or in the event of forgery, fraud, lack of authorization, or failure in checking academic backgrounds may result in the cancellation of admission or any other necessary measures.
- Students with foreign nationality are subject to compulsory application as local subscribers of the National Health Insurance.
- Other matters not specified shall be determined and handled by the University Admissions Committee.

1. Scholarships

A. Scholarship: 40% tuition waiver for international students admitted through the admissions process. 10-40% additional tuition waiver according to TOPIK level (additional tuition waiver for first and second semesters of the year of admission), 30-80% differential scholarships depending on GPA during semester

B. Scholarship type and scholarship amount may change partially depending on the University's financial situation

C. Scholarship requirements for transfer students (4th year) will be set separately




